

FINDMEA – BULLYING & HARASSMENT POLICY

What is Bullying?

Bullying is repeated unreasonable behaviour directed towards an employee or group of employees that creates risk to health and safety.

What is Harassment (Sexual Harassment or Physical Harassment)?

Harassment is the discrimination against an individual or group based on age, religion, gender, political preference or sexual preference.
